GUIDELINES

Who is eligible to receive funds?

Members / groups of the MNO Synod

Who administers the Foundation?

A Board of Directors administers the Foundation. The final responsibility for ensuring the funds are spent appropriately rests with the Manitoba Northwestern Ontario (MNO) Synod Council.

Who decides who gets funding?

The MNO Synod Council will appoint a panel of 3 to 5 people from the MNO Synod, annually. This panel will meet at least once per year to review the applications and make recommendations to the MNO Synod Council about the awarding of funds.

What kinds of projects will be considered for funding?

Key areas of ministry that will be funded have been identified but are not necessarily restricted to new missions, youth and children's ministry, internships and evangelism.

Where does the application for funding go?

Where will funds come from?

The MNO Synod Foundation for Mission and Ministry Inc. has been established to receive planned gifts. A goal of raising \$1,000,000.00 with a planned gift emphasis has been adopted. Funds will come from donations and interest generated by investment of these funds.

When will the funds be awarded?

Funds will be awarded yearly following the August MNO Synod Council meeting.

INFORMATION EACH APPLICATION SHOULD INCLUDE:

To ensure all projects are judged equally, applications for funding should include the following information:

- Name, address, phone number, and email address of group or person applying for the funds.
- Name, address, phone number and email address of person who will head the project, who will act as a contact to the MNO Synod Council, and who will be responsible for overseeing the funds.
- A description of who will benefit from the project.
- An outline of the goals of the project
- A description of other funding sources the project has.
- Where the project will be carried out.
- When the project will start and end.
- Why the funding is required.
- How the project will be accomplished.
- How much money is being requested.
